## JULY 21<sup>ST</sup> 2010 WINNERS CIRCLE

In the Fast Gas race, Robin Hirata of Wailuku in his Chevy Camaro, ran an ET of 9.287 at 143.87mph to take the win over Reid Yamamoto of Oahu in the Yellow Dragster, who ran an ET of 8.306 at 164.83mph. The 10.90 Super Street Class, was won by Mathew Simons of Haiku with his Mustang, running an ET of 10.865 at 126.51mph. The Runner-up was Gerald Fernandez of Pukalani in his Chevy Nova, who ran a 11.000 ET at 136.14mph but red lighted. Pro Gas, our 11.90 class, saw Kurt Buland of Kihei as the winner, running an 11.90 ET at 86.53mph in his Chevy II. The Runner-up was Mark Gouveia of Kahului with his black Challenger, running an ET of 11.888 at 96.31mph. Ryan Simons of Haiku driving his Mustang, was the winner of the Pro Street 12.90 Class and he did an ET of 13.039 clocking 96.31mph. Irene Hultquist of Kula in her Pontiac T/A was Runner-up, finishing with an ET of 13.016 at 85.71mph. In Street Competition, John Hultquist of Kihei with his Chevy Nova, took the win with an ET of 16.539 at 77.87mph over Thomas Cunningham Kihei in his red Corvette which ran an ET of 13.466 at 101.26mph. In the Bikes Class, Gabriel Kimbrell in his Hayabusa of Kahului, won with an ET of 9.706 running 148.16. Bikes Runner-up was Mark Collo on his Suzuki, out of Kahului, ran an ET of 9.345 at a speed of 147.61mph.

In the Jr. Dragster race, William Sanchez, Jr. of Wailuku won with an ET of 8.787 at 75.65mph over Soloman Palad of Wailuku who ran 65.88mph, clocking an ET of 9.104.
